Size Guide

Choosing the right frame size helps ensure your reading glasses are comfortable and sit correctly throughout the day. Each pair of Good Eyes readers is measured using the following standard dimensions.

Frame Width

The total width of the frame from one outer edge to the other. This gives an overall indication of how wide the glasses will sit on your face.

Lens Width

The width of one lens at its widest point. Larger lens widths generally provide a broader field of vision and can influence the overall appearance of the frame.

Lens Height

The height of one lens from top to bottom. This measurement affects the depth of the lens and the overall look of the frame.

Bridge Width

The distance between the two lenses where the frame rests on your nose. A well-fitting bridge helps keep your glasses comfortable and securely in place.

Temple Length

The length of each arm, measured from the hinge to the tip that sits behind your ear. The correct temple length contributes to a comfortable, secure fit.
